<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Any medications you bring MUST be in original containers with dosage information.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> For prescription medications, you must have the medication in original prescription container with physician dosage information <input type="checkbox"/> OTC medications must be in original containers with dosage information (for example, you cannot bring headache medication pills in a separate baggy, they must be in an original container). <p>NOTE: If you have not submitted BOTH Medical Administration Authorization Forms you will not be permitted to take any medications while at Summer Academy.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Photo ID (Current school picture ID, Driver's license/permit, Green Card or Passport) Note: You will not be allowed on NASA property without a PHOTO ID</p>

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Toiletries and Personal Hygiene Products including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss <input type="checkbox"/> Shampoo, conditioner, and/or soap <input type="checkbox"/> Shower sandals <input type="checkbox"/> Bathroom caddy to carry toiletries to-from bathroom <input type="checkbox"/> Other personal hygiene products <input type="checkbox"/> Contact lenses/glasses <input type="checkbox"/> Brush/comb <input type="checkbox"/> Hair dryer/hair styling tools (if needed) <input type="checkbox"/> Travel Iron (optional, but for presentations it is nice to have clothes nicely pressed) <input type="checkbox"/> Ear plugs (optional) <input type="checkbox"/> Bug spray, sunscreen, sunglasses
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Technology and Academy Supplies including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Laptop and Charger (not mandatory, but recommended) <input type="checkbox"/> Camera <input type="checkbox"/> Phone charger <input type="checkbox"/> Alarm clock (we do not do wake-up calls) <input type="checkbox"/> Flash drive <input type="checkbox"/> Notebook <input type="checkbox"/> Writing utensils (pencils/pens/highlighters)

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>NASA Clothing. Clothing needed for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday while at NASA</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Shirts: Shirts with buttons and collars - could be golf/polo style or button down <i>Note: Absolutely no tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts while at NASA. You are a working NASA professional this week so Scholars are expected to dress business casual.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Pants: Khakis, Chinos and/or Jeans are permitted while at NASA. <i>Note: Absolutely no pants with rips, holes, stains, tears, etc. are allowed while at NASA.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Shoes: Closed-toed shoes must be worn at NASA. We recommend comfortable sneakers or nice comfortable shoes as we will be doing lots of walking. <i>Note: Crocs and sandals with socks are NOT considered closed-toed. Your feet must be completely covered while at NASA.</i>

You will be provided ONE VSCS Academy Polo which will be worn on Thursday for NASA Presentations and Friday morning for the Closing Ceremony.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Students should wear khaki pants with a belt for Thursday's presentation at NASA. <i>Note: Gentlemen, shirts must be tucked into pants and belted at the waist during NASA activities. Ladies, your shirts must fall below the waistband of your pants.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>UMES Clothing. Clothing while at UMES is casual. When we get back from NASA WFF you will be able to change into more comfortable clothing for the evening portion of our days.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Shirts: T-shirts are permitted <i>Note: Absolutely no tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts, midriff-showing shirts, shirts with offensive logos/language/images, shirts with rips/gashes/holes, are allowed while attending Summer Academy.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Pants/Shorts: Khakis, Chinos, Jeans, athletic pants, shorts and/or skorts that extend beyond the fingertips when standing with arms at your side are permitted when at UMES. <i>Note: Absolutely no pants with rips, holes, stains, tears, etc. are allowed while at Summer Academy.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Shoes: Comfortable closed-toed or open-toed shoes are allowed. <i>Note: Crocs and sandals are permitted when at UMES, but do know that we will be doing a lot of walking, so make sure your shoe choices are comfortable.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Socks: Bring several pairs of socks for the week. <i>Note: We will be bowling on Thursday evening and socks are required to participate.</i> <input type="checkbox"/> Nightwear: Please bring sweatpants, t-shirts and/or pajamas to sleep in while in the dorms. <input type="checkbox"/> Other: Undergarments, slippers, sweatshirts, sweaters, hoodies <i>Note: Although it is likely going to be VERY hot outside, some of the buildings may be cold, so bring at least one warm article of clothing.</i>
