Scholarships

Virginia Space Grant Consortium (VSGC) provides STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Bridge Scholarships of \$1,000 to students who will be sophomores during the 2021-2022 academic year.

Students from any federally recognized minority group in STEM and enrolled full-time in a program of STEM at one of the five Virginia Space Grant member universities are strongly encouraged to apply.

Students who are members of a federally recognized minority, including ethnicities such as African American, Native American, Hispanic, or Pacific Islanders, and female student are strongly encouraged to apply.

About the VSGC

The Virginia Space Grant Consortium (VSGC) is a coalition of five Virginia colleges and universities, NASA, state educational agencies and other institutions representing diverse STEM education and research.

VSGC offers a wide range of student opportunities including fellowships, scholarships, internships, research experiences, and student flight projects.

Eligibility

- U.S. citizen
- Enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student (minimum 12 credit hours) at one of the Virginia Space Grant
 Consortium member institutions. Must have completed at least one semester majoring in STEM at time of application.
- Grade point average of at least 3.0
- Must have completed at least one year of an undergraduate program and be classified as a sophomore during the 2021-2022 academic year. Students who are completing the first course sequence in their major are eligible, even if they have academic standing higher than sophomore year.
