Graduate STEM **Research Fellowships**

The Virginia Space Grant Consortium (VSGC) is a coalition of five Virginia colleges and universities, NASA, state educational agencies and other institutions representing diverse STEM education and research. VSGC offers a wide range of student opportunities including fellowships, scholarships, internships, research experiences, and student flight projects.

Fellowships

The Virginia Space Grant Consortium I.U.S. citizen (VSGC) provides \$6,000 graduate research fellowships to students majoring in STEM disciplines (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math). Fellowships require students to participate in a facultymentored research experience that aligns with one of NASA's Mission Directorates. Awardees are required to use \$1,000 from the Fellowship to support travel to related conferences and for research-related supplies and ${f I}$ materials. Awards are renewable for 1 one year for students making satisfactory academic and research progress.

Eligibility

- •Graduation date no sooner than May, 2026
- Conducting research that supports NASA's mission
- •Grade point average of at least 3.0 I ∙Must be receiving matching funds
- of at least \$6,000 from applicant's academic institution enrolled as a full-
- I. time graduate student at one of


