The Virginia Space Grant Consortium (VSGC) is a coalition of five Virginia colleges and universities, NASA, state educational agencies and other institutions representing diverse STEM education and research. VSGC offers a wide range of student opportunities including fellowships, scholarships, internships, research experiences, and student flight projects.

Fellowships

(VSGC) provides \$6,000 graduate research fellowships to students majoring in STEM disciplines (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math). Fellowships require students to participate in a facultymentored research experience that aligns with one of NASA's Mission Directorates. Awardees are required to use \$1,000 from the Fellowship to support travel to related conferences and for research-related supplies and lacksquarematerials. Awards are renewable for one year for students making satisfactory academic and research progress.

Eligibility

■ ·Conducting research that supports NASA's mission

·Grade point average of at least 3.0 • Must be receiving matching funds

of at least \$6.000 from applicant's academic institution enrolled as a fulltime graduate student at one of the Virginia Space Grant Consortium member institutions:
