The Virginia Space Grant Consortium is offering an online Private Pilot Ground School course in partnership with Virginia Peninsula Community College.

The course will be offered as a hybrid live and asynchronous online program in Fall 2022 from September 15 through December 17, 2022. Live lecture sessions will take place on Thursdays from 6 pm - 9 pm. Students in this program will register at no cost at Virginia Peninsula Community College upon acceptance to the program and commit to completing the 8-week online course in order to receive the instructor's signature on their FAA license paperwork. Participants who successfully complete the course will be eligible to apply for one of eleven scholarships for 40 hours of flight instruction.

Eligibility: Students must be high school students and have at least a 3.0 GPA, be U.S. citizens, be Virginia residents and be 16 years old by the start of the course. They must also be able to pass an FAA flight physical exam. Exam guidelines can be found at:
